Hurricane Harvey Church Partnership

FOR is partnering with CityView Church in Pearland, TX (one of the hardest hit areas in Houston). What does this mean? First, we are going to give them some money so they can help those in need. CityView Church has already provided truckloads of supplies to area shelters including food, water, diapers, socks, and underwear. They have also supplied meals for hundreds, purchased and delivered medicine, and provided pastoral counseling at shelters. We have already sent them \$2,000 from our Benevolence Fund. If you would like to help with something else, you can write a check and put 'Harvey' in the memo or use our app or website and select Benevolence. Second, we are going to be praying for them. Julia Stambaugh is going to maintain a prayer update. If you would like to be included in this, just check the Harvey box on your community card.

For now, Pastor Jason at CityView asks for you to pray for first responders, doctors, and nurses as they help people. Pray for those in shelters and those providing relief. Pray for the city and their rebuilding efforts.

Finally, I would ask you to say a special prayer for Jess Fischer, a member at FOR and a Psychologist who is deployed there from Fort Carson for 30 days.
